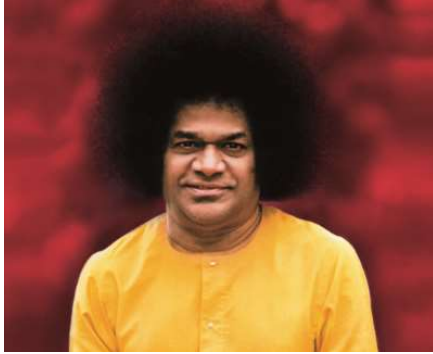

Uniqueness of Gurukulam

Our Gurukulam system is based on the philosophy of our Founder Sri Sathya Sai Baba who firmly believed that integrated development in children is possible only with the right balance of academic, moral and spiritual education. In the recent times, we have reviewed our approach and taken necessary steps to rededicate ourselves to our Founder's vision, by imparting high quality academic education, by teaching sciences alongside spirituality, humanities alongside divinity, and excellence alongside enlightenment.

For the child to have a well-rounded personality and be able to withstand the pressures of life, in any progressive society, there needs to be equal emphasis on Physical, Intellectual, Emotional and Spiritual aspects. Unfortunately, some or the other aspect of this holistic education philosophy is found lacking in most of the present-day educational pedagogy due to its excessive focus on the academic aspect alone, and thus this needs immediate rectification. At SSSLSG, moral and spiritual education based on the Universal Human Values of Love, Right Conduct, Truth, Peace and Non-violence is imparted to students

Students at the Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulam are exposed to a unique learning model that isn't just limited to classrooms. From hostel rooms to dining halls to the playground, students are exposed to values and lessons everywhere – education with the heart.

Daily Routine *Early to Rise and Early to Bed*

The daily routine begins with chanting Suprabhatam at 5 a.m. and then undertaking yogasana, meditation, exercises etc. After breakfast, the academic classes begin from 8 a.m., with a one-hour break for lunch. Studies continue till 4 p.m., and this includes the time for practical work and study time as well.

Evening activities include outdoor games, followed by evening satsang and later study time for Indian Culture and Spirituality. Students go to bed early after a glass of milk and night prayers.

Affiliation to NIOS

All Students at Gurukulam will be studying under [NIOS] National Institute of Open Schooling system.

NIOS is an Autonomous Institute under Ministry of Education, Govt. of India

Continuing Education Policy

Once enrolled in the Gurukulam, students commit to a continuous learning journey until they are fully prepared for employment". To facilitate this, we offer a range of courses that enable students to progress in their area of interest and develop skills for perfection. This policy ensures students receive comprehensive education and training, empowering them to achieve their full potential.

Eligibility for Admission

Students (Boys/Girls) who have passed 5th std / studying now and are born between **1st April 2013 and 31st Mar 2015 only can apply.**

Seva Activities

Parents of students admitted to any of our gurukulam are required to participate in "Seva Activities" of the Trust for two weeks in a year (one week in the Sri Madhusudhan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research at Muddenahalli and the other week in any of the nearest campuses/gurukulams or any of the trust services- Annapoorna breakfast seva, Sri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospitals.]

We provide free education, encompassing all aspects of a student's life, from education and food to accommodation, clothing, and health services. We take care of all necessary items, making our institution a second home for students. We offer well-balanced, nutritious, and healthy vegetarian meals to all students.
